Criteria: The nominee must be a CalCPA member.*

Individuals nominated may be chosen from any facet of the accounting profession. The nominee may be a practicing accountant in private, public, or government accounting.

The nominee should be an individual who has 1-5 years of work experience and has made an immediate or sustained contribution to their firm, company or community. The nominee is not required to be licensed.
