## **2010 LA Chapter Scholarship Guidelines**

The Los Angeles Chapter is looking for top students attending a university/college in the Los Angeles County region who meet the following criteria in each scholarship category. The selected winners will receive a scholarship ranging from \$1,000 to \$4,000 and a year's membership in the California Society of CPAs. In addition, one recipient will be awarded a multi-year endowment scholarship of up to \$7,000.

### **GENERAL ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP**

- Have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement
- Be an accounting or equivalent major
- Have taken at least one upper division accounting course and be enrolled currently in one other accounting course
- Must graduate before December 2012
- Have demonstrated leadership and significant participation in community service in either campus or off-campus organizations.
- University/college must reside within the LA Chapter territory.
- Must be present to receive award. Awards given at our LA Installation program in May 2010.

### **MULTI-YEAR ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

- Have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement
- Be an accounting or equivalent major
- Currently enrolled in, or already completed, Principles of Accounting or a more advanced accounting course with plans for taking additional accounting courses.
- Must graduate before December 2012. No awards given after graduation date.
- Have demonstrated leadership and significant participation in community service in either campus or off-campus organizations.
- Intend to enter the accounting profession in California throughout the term of the endowment scholarship
- Complete all requirements needed to sit for the CPA exam
- In order to receive three full annual installments (\$1,500, \$2,500, \$3,000) of the Multi-Year Scholarship, all requirements must be completed before graduation date. No installments will be given after graduation date.
- University/college must reside within the LA Chapter territory.
- Must be present to receive award. Awards given at our LA Installation program in May 2010.

For consideration, the applicant **must submit** the following for consideration: **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

1. Resume
2. Two letters of recommendation from an Accounting Professor/Dean
3. Scholarship Application Request
4. Current OFFICIAL transcripts (must be included in package)
5. A typed essay not to exceed one page on your educational, career goals and how you envision your involvement with CalCPA.
