Requirements for Eligibility: Candidate must be a full or part time student with a declared accounting major or an emphasis in accounting (if a community college student), who will be a junior or senior enrolled in a four-year university during the fall of 2009, and whose expected graduation date is December 2009 or later. The school must be located within the Sacramento Chapter's geographical boundaries (from the southern borders of Napa, Yolo, Sacramento, Amador, Alpine & Solano Counties north to the Oregon border and east to the Nevada border, excluding the coastal counties of San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Mendocino, Humboldt & Del Norte Counties).
