Keeping Up With New Tax Perspectives

presented by Annette Nellen, CPA, Esq.

While the centerpiece of 2009 tax changes was the economic stimulus package, there have been many additional developments of note in the past year from all branches of government and affecting all areas of tax practice. Ms. Nellen's presentation will summarize key developments of the past year of relevance to individuals and Silicon Valley businesses at both the federal and state levels. A crystal ball look into the balance of 2010 will also be provided.

Ms. Nellen is a professor in and director of San José State University's Masters of Science in Taxation program. She teaches courses on tax research, accounting methods, high tech tax matters, property transactions, state income tax, and tax policy and reform. Annette is a frequent speaker and author on tax policy topics. She has served on the AICPA Tax Executive Committee and is presently chair of the California State Bar's Tax Policy, Practice & Legislation Committee. In 2000, Annette served on the academic panel that advised the Joint Committee on Taxation staff for the tax law simplification study submitted to Congress. She has testified before tax committees of the California legislature and state tax commissions. Annette is a graduate of CSU Northridge, Pepperdine, and Loyola Law School. Prior to joining SJSU in 1990, Annette was with Ernst & Young and the IRS.
