

# Administrative Rules for Federal Grants (FFGV)

## Course Overview

Almost all federal grant programs require grantees to comply with cross-cutting administrative rules—or face significant cost disallowances and administrative sanctions. Understand the administrative rules that apply to virtually all federal grantees, including the hierarchy of rules, reports and records, and after-grant requirements. Build your expertise so you can ensure that your clients conform to federal administrative requirements and avoid claims for large refunds or being designated a high-risk grantee.

- Identify which activities are permitted and which are not.
- Recognize which actions require prior approval.
- Determine the responsibilities that continue after the grant has been completed.
